VISITORS' CHARTER

WELCOME TO THE MAMCO!

The MAMCO is a space which is open to all and which exhibits artworks from the past fifty years. It requires everyone's attention and respect.

So that your encounter with original and often fragile works can take place in the best possible conditions, here are some rules to respect:

ARRIVING AT THE MAMCO:

- > No bags are allowed in the exhibition spaces, even the most discreet ones. Lockers are available in the basement of the museum.
- > The lockers work using a 2 CHF coin. You can then recover your money on leaving.
- > Out of respect for others, please make telephone calls outside the museum. During guided visits, please put your telephone into silent mode.
- > Drinks, food and chewing-gum are not allowed in the exhibition spaces.

VISITING EXHIBITIONS:

- > Take the others into consideration and allow them to visit the museum in peace.
- > Please do not run, jostle, or lean against the walls, display cases or plinths. An accident can happen at any time.
- > Be attentive to your surroundings, so as not to damage anything: contemporary art can be hung on the wall, but it can also be displayed on the floor or suspended in mid-air.
- > Do not touch the objects. Touching leaves behind marks which may damage the artworks irremediably. Your fingerprints contain fats and acids which very few materials can tolerate over time.
- > Only pencils are allowed in the exhibition spaces.
- > It is permitted to photograph the artworks, but without a flash and without a tripod.
